

Central Oregon Community College Foundation Mid Oregon Credit Union Annual Scholarship



The COCC foundation Scholarship Program offers scholarships from more than 100 different donors. Completing the application enables the applicant to compete for any COCC Foundation Scholarship for which he or she may qualify during the 2007-2008 school year. The applicant may apply only once each academic year unless he or she has additional or updated information.

Applicants who are not awarded in the first selection period will be reconsidered in the second selection period if their application is complete. Should an applicant be awarded, he or she will be notified by mail. OSU Cascades students need to apply for scholarships through OSU Cascades.

1. Complete the online COCC Foundation Scholarship application.
2. Submit transcripts other than COCC transcripts to COCC Financial Aid Office.

COCC Scholarships will be awarded according to the following schedule:

- Apply by 11:59 p.m. on March 9, 2007, and you will be notified of awards by April 2, 2007
- Apply by 11:59 p.m. on July 26, 2007, and you will be notified of awards by August 15, 2007

To be eligible for the Mid Oregon Credit Union COCC Foundation Scholarship:

1. Must be an in-district resident for at least one year, have a 2.5 or higher GPA, enrolled in a degree or certificate program and demonstrate financial need. The student must be a Central Oregon high school graduate and a resident of Mid Oregon Credit Union area of membership; Deschutes, Jefferson, or Crook County.
2. The award will be for tuition for the academic year.
3. The Central Oregon Community College Foundation Scholarship Committee selects the recipient.
4. Disbursement of the awards will be made in equal amounts at the beginning of each regular term.
5. Be admitted to COCC for the 2007-2008 academic year.
6. Be enrolled in a minimum of six credits each term to receive this scholarship (full-time student preferred). Students enrolled in less than 12 credits will receive prorated awards based on actual enrollment. **Exception:** Nursing students enrolled in 9+ credits are considered full-time for scholarship awarding purposes.
7. Complete the 2007-2008 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online. This should be done at least four weeks prior to the deadline in order to be received by COCC in a timely manner. COCC's Federal school code is 003188.
8. Enroll and attend fall term, 2007.

If you receive a foundation Scholarship, SEOG, Stafford Loans, and/or Federal Work Study may be reduced and if you transfer to any other school during the academic year, including OSU Cascade, any scholarship award will be canceled.
